# I) **DESIGNER**

#### 1. SCOPE OF WORK

- To assist the Handloom Weavers Co-operative Societies in modifying the designs, colour combination and textures of the fabrics.
- To develop a range of handloom products as per market requirements.
- To coordinate with the Marketing & Production Executives of Co-optex and the Handloom Weavers Co-operative Societies to undertake to designing as per requirements of importers/buying agents/overseas buyers. Samples to be developed under the project from the stage of designs into products.
- To document the designs and products developed.
- To train weavers and technical staff of the Handloom Weavers Co-operative Societies to convert paper designs into fabrics/end products.

Design development activities include designer input towards textile techniques, motifs, design & colour trend and redefined usage of fabrics, usage of existing garment styles, product development using new techniques.

#### 2. Eligibility

The applicant should have passed out from a Textile Design Institute of reputed. The applicant should have atleast 3 years of working experience as Textile Designer, preferably with an experience of working in Textiles Sector and having knowledge in CATD (Computer aided Textile Designing).

#### 3. Terms & Conditions

- The Designer shall identify the products before commencement of new design development by visiting Handloom Weaver Co-operative Societies.
- The designer will provide only those ranges of products which are acceptable to the targeted market / buyer and shall be responsible for the success of the products.

#### c) Train the Weaver

 To train / enroll the weavers to translate the paper designs on to the fabric.

- By preparing write ups and support in display of exhibition.
- Visual merchandising / display of stock at select showrooms

#### e) Documentation of the Designs & Products Developed

- To document the designs and products developed by the designer.
- Other marketing activities as and when entrusted.
